You'll need to register to post comments or reply. (Click on the 'Register' button in the upper right corner of the page.) If you want to suggest additional threads on transparency, you can let us know by e-mail or letter at the address above.

We will use the Blog to provide the public with information about the progress of the project, including discussion of the public input that we have received and possible future directions of the project.
